
INSTALL

INSTALLING EASY SOCIAL SHARE BUTTONS

1. Upload **easy-social-share-buttons** folder to your WordPress plugins directory (/wp-content/plugins/) or use provided in folder webupload zip file for upload via WordPress admin screen.

Activate from WordPress menu Plugins section and select Installed Plugins

2. Locate **Easy Social Share Buttons for WordPress** and press **Activate** button



3. A new option will appear in WordPress admin menu: **Easy Social Share Buttons** where you can configure plugin settings.

UPDATING EASY SOCIAL SHARE BUTTONS

Upload **easy-social-share-buttons** folder to your WordPress plugins directory (/wp-content/plugins/) to overwrite previous installation. There is no need to deactivate plugin while you do this update.

PLUGIN CONFIGURATION

To configure plugin work locate **Easy Social Share Buttons** menu in WordPress admin menu.

MAIN SETTINGS

TEMPLATE

Easy Social Share Buttons for WordPress comes equipped with prebuild themes. Here you will choose default theme that will be used but you are also able to set custom theme for post/page in its settings box (see on post/page settings).

Template:

This will be your default theme for site. You are able to select different theme for each post/page.





Social Networks section contains list with support from your version social networks for share. You can choose which to appear with ticking box in front of each. You are able to reorder them with drag and drop in way you wish to appear.

You can also adjust alignment of buttons. Now you are able to select from left (default), right or center display or activate option to display full width share buttons. Full width share buttons option is also available in each post/page panel option and can be controlled from there.

TWITTER ADDITIONAL OPTIONS

Twitter Additional Options

Twitter share short url:
Activate this option to share short url with Twitter.

Twitter username to be mentioned:
If you wish a twitter username to be mentioned in tweet write it here. Enter your username without @ - example **twittername**. This text will be appended to tweet message at the end. Please note that if you activate custom share address option this will be added to custom share message.

Twitter hashtags to be added:
If you wish hashtags to be added to message write theme here. You can set one or more (if more then one separate them with comma (,)) Example: demotag1,demotag2.

Don't use popup window for Tweeter Share:
If you have issue with Twitter share button opening same window but not share a tweet window activate this option to fix it.

In Twitter additional options you may provide:

- **Twitter username to be mentioned** – this will add provided username to tweet as **via @username**. Here you need to provide twitter user without @
- **Twitter hashtags to be added** – if you wish **hashtags** to be mention in tweet you can add them here (if more than one separate with , (comma)).
- **Don't use popup window for Tweeter Share** – if you have another instance of twitter tweet button on your site this may cause to display it twice or reload page without opening tweet window. Activate this option to fix this issue.
- **Twitter share short url** – this option allows you to share short url address only for Twitter. If you have activated global option for share short url this will be bypassed.

PINTEREST ADDITIONAL OPTIONS

Pinterest Additional Options

Disable Pinterest sniff for images:
If you disable Pinterest sniff for images plugin will use for share post featured image or custom share image you provide.

In Pinterest additional options you may provide:

- **Disable Pinterest sniff for images** – this option will disable Pinterest sniff for images on your site and featured post/page image will be used for default sharing

FACEBOOK ADDITIONAL OPTIONS

Facebook Additional Options

Use Facebook Advanced Sharing:
Enable this option if you wish to share custom share message. This option require to be set Facebook Application and you need to provide Facebook Application ID.

Facebook Application ID:
For proper work of advanced Facebook sharing you need to provide application id. If you don't have you need to create one. To create Facebook Application use this link:
<http://developers.facebook.com/apps/>

Display Facebook Total Count:
Enable this option if you wish to display total count not only share count.

In Facebook additional options you may provide:

- **Use Facebook Advanced Sharing** – According to latest changes of Facebook API previous existing methods for custom sharing with options are removed. To customize your share message you can do this with current page Open Graph tags or by activating Use Facebook Advanced Sharing. Facebook Advanced Sharing requires to have created Facebook Application which is used for sharing the message. After creating it you need to write Application ID in Facebook Application ID field
- **Facebook Application ID** – this is Facebook Application ID when you use activate custom share message. Applications are specific for current site so if you don't have one open <http://developers.facebook.com/apps/> and create a new one. At the end of this manual you can see quick guide how to create Facebook Application.
- **Display Facebook Total Count** – plugin is configured by default to display only share count. If you wish to display total count activate this option.

CLICK LOG AND STATISTICS

Click Log and Statistics

Activate Statistics:
Click statistics handle click on share buttons and you are able to see detailed view of user activity. Please note that plugin log clicks of buttons.

Click log and statistics is function which allows you to track user click overs share buttons and generate reports for user activity. This is very helpful function to analyze user activity over your site. You can view total statistic by post/page or detailed report for selected month. For more information refer to **Click Statistics** section in this manual.

SOCIAL SHARE OPTIMIZATION

Social Share Optimization (SSO)

Automatically generate and insert open graph meta tags for post/pages:

Open Graph meta tags are used to optimize social sharing. This option will include following tags og:title, og:description, og:url, og:image, og:type, og:site_name.

Automatically generate and insert Twitter Cards meta tags for post/pages:

Twitter Site Username:

Default Twitter Card type:

Easy Social Share Buttons for WordPress includes build in option for automated generation of Open Graph Meta Tags and Twitter Cards. These tags are used to optimize social sharing information.

If you activate option for Open Graph tags generator plugin will automatically generate following tags for post and pages:

- og:title – title of post/page
- og:description – excerpt for post/page
- og:url – url of post/page
- og:image – featured post/page image
- og:type – pass by default article
- og:site_name – use blog name as value

If you activate Twitter Card generation option following tags will be generated:

- twitter:title – title of post/page
- twitter:description – excerpt for post/page
- twitter:url – url of post/page
- twitter:image:src – featured post/page image only if Summary card with image is selected
- twitter:card – pass value of selected card type
- twitter:site – pass value of twitter site user
- twitter:domain - use blog name as value

SOCIAL LIKE AND SUBSCRIBE BUTTONS

This setting will allow you to include native social buttons: Facebook Like, Google +1, Twitter Follow and vk.com Like. If you wish this buttons to be displayed on same line as share buttons activate option **Display on same line**.

Display on same line:

Activating this option will display native social network buttons on same line with share buttons.

FACEBOOK LIKE

This option will include Facebook Like button into your set of buttons.

Please note that if your site is already loading Facebook Api (you have such button) you need to activate option **My site already uses Facebook Api** to avoid load it again and overwrite your other settings for like button.

GOOGLE +1

This option will include Google +1 button into your set of buttons.

To work proper this button requires you to create vk.com application for each site. To do this open link provided in description and follow on screen instructions.

TWITTER FOLLOW

This option will include Twitter follow user button into your set of buttons.

Please note that Twitter follow user must be inserted without @ (for example: **appscreo**)

YOUTUBE SUBSCRIBE

This option will include YouTube Subscribe to your channel button in native buttons.

Channel Name or ID: You can find your YouTube channel id here .	<input type="text"/>

PINTEREST FOLLOW

This option will include Pinterest Follow button in native like buttons.

Display name on buttons is actually text you wish people to see on follow button.

ACTIVATE CUSTOM LIKE ADDRESSES

If you wish Facebook Like and Google +1 buttons to have custom addresses (not current post/page) you need to activate this option and provide them in boxes below. This is useful if you wish to provide your current Facebook Fan Page for like or your Google +1 page. Also you can use it to pass you site for like or +1. You are also able to set custom share/like address on each post/page.

i This option allows you to send different address for native social network buttons to like. If you have activated custom share message this will overwrite address you send from custom share message options but only for social network native buttons.

Address for Facebook Like Button:

This can be your Facebook Fan Page url or other url address you wish people to like.

Address for Google +1 Button:

This can be your Google +1 Page url or other url address you wish people to like.

URL SHORTENER

URL Shortener option is added if you wish to users to share like short address. You may select between build in WordPress function (especially if you have custom short address generation already included), goo.gl function for url shortening or bit.ly service.

If you activate bit.ly service for short urls you need to provide valid bit.ly username and API key (API key is located in your profile of bit.ly).

Please note that if you have start sharing your full address this will reset counters to zero because address will different then address you have already used.

URL Shortener

i Using shortlinks will generate unique shortlinks for pages/posts. If you have shared till now full address of you current post/page using shortlink will make counters of sharing to start from 0.

Use wp_get_shortlink():
If you wish to share shortlink for your post or pages using build in WordPress shortlink function activate this option.

Use goo.gl to generate short URL:
If you wish to use goo.gl service to generate shortlinks for your pages or posts activate this option.

Use bit.ly to generate short URL:
If you wish to use bit.ly service to generate shortlinks for your pages or posts activate this option.

CUSTOM SHARE MESSAGE

Custom share message is option created if you wish to pass custom share address and message to buttons which will avoid using current page/post title and address (each page/post will share entered here information). You are also able to set custom share/like address on each post/page.

Custom Share Message:
This option allows you to pass custom message to share (not all networks support this).

Custom Share URL:
This option allows you to pass custom url to share (all networks support this).

Custom Share Image URL:
This option allows you to pass custom image to your share message (only Facebook and Pinterest support this).

Custom Share Description:
This option allows you to pass custom extended description to your share message (only Facebook and Pinterest support this).

Please note that **Custom Share Image URL** and **Custom Share Description** fields are available only for Facebook and Pinterest – over social networks does not support this parameters.

ADVANCED CUSTOM SHARE

Advanced Custom Share is option which allows you set different share address for each social network. Please note that not all networks support full customization of messages. Setting parameters for social network will have highest priority for custom sharing and will overwrite settings from custom share message option.

CUSTOMIZE E-MAIL MESSAGE

i You can customize texts to display when visitors share your content by mail button. To perform customization, you can use `%%title%%`, `%%siteurl%%` or `%%permalink%%` variables.

If you have activated send to mail option here you can customize message that will be shared. Users are not able to change this message (they only will see what will share). You can also activate copy to admin option with entering your email address in **Send copy of all messages to**.

In this section you are also able to translate all strings passed to send mail screen.

- **Disable menu in WordPress admin bar** – this will make Easy Social Share Buttons to disappear from WordPress administration bar
- **Move plugin options under settings menu** – if you want to restrict access to settings this is good solution – plugin settings will be moved to settings menu.
- **I am using Google Analytics for WordPress by Yoast** – this is important option that must be activated if you are using Google Analytics for WordPress and have activated option to Track outbound clicks & downloads

Social Fans Counter is new module in Easy Social Share Buttons for WordPress which allows you to include social fan counters with widget or shortcode.

Social Fans Counter can be insert as Widget (Easy Social Fans Counter Widget) or with shortcode [essb-fans] where you wish to display it. Shortcode can be used with following options:

style - this is template of buttons. You can choose between: muted, colored, flat, metro

cols - choose how many columns to be used in redner. You can choose between 1,2,3,4

width - instead of cols you can set exact with of buttons. For example you may enter 100 for 100px

With drag and drop you are able to rearrange network positions.

Cache Time

In cache time you enter value of hours after which counters will refresh. By pressing save button in settings cache option is removed and counters will be loaded again. You can choose to display counters from widget. You can use as many time widget as you need. Options are:

- Title – title of widget box (you may not pass if you wish)
- Style – this is template for buttons. Every widget may have different template
- Columns – choose in how many columns to render buttons
- Width – set fixed width of buttons. When you set fixed width you may select blank for columns

DISPLAY FROM SHORTCODE

You are also able to display fans counter with shortcode [essb-fans]. Shortcode has following options:

- **style** - this is template of buttons. You can choose between: **mutted, colored, flat, metro**
- **cols** - choose how many columns to be used in redner. You can choose between **1,2,3,4**
- **width** - instead of cols you can set exact with of buttons. For example you may enter 100 for 100px

DISPLAY SETTINGS

Display setting section handles all general options on how your buttons will display on site.

WHERE TO DISPLAY BUTTONS

This is list of all your current post/page types you have on site. You need to set option in front of each of them where you wish buttons to display automatically. You are able to hide buttons on specific post/page via post/page settings or activate buttons via **shortcode** where you wish even if this post type is not included in this list.

Where to display buttons:

Choose post types where you wish buttons to appear. If you are running **WooCommerce** store you can choose between post type **Products** which will display share buttons into product description or option to display buttons below price.

- Posts
- Pages
- Media
- Products
- Coupons
- Facebook fanpages
- Job Listings
- Lists of articles
(blog, archives, search results, etc.)

WooCommerce Products
(Activate share buttons for WooCommerce Products)

Display in post excerpt
(Activate this option if your theme is using excerpts and you wish to display share buttons in excerpts)

If you are using **WooCommerce** on your site you are able to choose where buttons to appear:

- In product description
- Below price (using build in filter of **WooCommerce** for share buttons)

BBPRESS DISPLAY

bbPress Display

Display in forums:
This will allow users to share forum page.

Display in topics:
This will allow users to share topic page.

You are able to display share buttons in bbPress forums and threads. To do this all you need is to activate desired locations with checkboxes. Position of buttons is applied for bbPress display.

BUDDYPRESS DISPLAY

BuddyPress Display

Display in activity:
This will allow users to share activities.


Display on group page:
This will allow users to share group page.

You are able to activate buttons to be displayed in BuddyPress. Currently supported locations are Activity and Group page. Position of buttons is not applied for this display.

POSITION OF BUTTONS

You can select between 7 automatic display methods of buttons. You can also select different method for each post/page in its settings.

- **Content bottom** – this will render buttons just after content ends
- **Content top** – this will render buttons on top of content
- **Both (content bottom and content top)** – this will render buttons on top and bottom of content
- **Float from content top** – this will render buttons on top of content and will float with scroll down
- **Sidebar** – this will render buttons as sidebar. Sidebar can be positioned left, right or bottom
- **Pop up** – this will render buttons as popup window
- **Like top/Share bottom** – this method will render native social like buttons on top of post and share buttons in bottom
- **Share top/Like bottom** – this method will render share buttons on top of post/page and native like buttons in bottom
- **Shortcode call only** – this will activate buttons only after shortcode call



You are also able to use **shortcode** with combination with any of this display methods. For example you can call buttons as popup with delay from **shortcode** and use default display method float from content top.

Hide buttons on low resolution mobile devices:

This option will hide buttons on mobile devices with resolution lower than 740px.

Activate Sidebar as another display method:

This option will allow you to display buttons as sidebar in combination with default selected display method.

Activate Popup as another display method:

This option will allow you to display buttons as popup window in combination with default selected display method.

These two options allow you to add another display method with selected one. You can set default display to be top and activate sidebar or popup as another display method and both will be rendered. You are also able to control these settings for each post/page.

FLOAT FROM TOP SETTINGS

Float from top settings handles specific settings only for float from top display method.

Set custom top of float bar:

If your curent theme has fixed bar or menu you may need to provide custom top position of float or it will be rendered below this sticked bar. For example you can try with value 40 (which is equal to 40px from top).

Background color of float bar:

Default color provided for background of float bar is #FFFFFF. If you wish to change it you can enter other color in hex or rgba. For example your can set #e1e1e1 or rgba(200,200,200,1)

If your theme uses other stick to top element (for example menu) you may need to provide offset from top or your float bar may appear below buttons. Also you are able to change color of background (default is white #FFFFFF) with selected from you to fit your theme best. You can provide HEX color or RGBA value. For example you can use rgba(255,255,255,0.7) which will make a semi-transparent white background which is nice effect when your bar floats.

SIDEBAR SETTINGS

This option allows you to select default sidebar appearance. You can choose from left (default), right or bottom. On each post/page you are also able to select sidebar position.

Sidebar appearance:

You choose different position for sidebar. Available options are Left (default), Right and Bottom

Sticky Sidebar – sticky sidebar option allows you to limit sidebar while you scroll on page to avoid entering footer area (it will only float until content end and hide when you reach footer).

POPUP WINDOW SETTINGS

These options allow you to tune your popup window display.

Popup window title:	<input type="text"/>
Automatically close popup after (sec): You can provide seconds and after they expire window will close automatically. User can close this window manually by pressing close button.	<input type="text"/>
Display popup window after (sec): If you wish popup window to appear after amount of seconds you can provide them here. Leave blank for immediate popup after page load.	<input type="text"/>

- **Popup window title** – this will be title of popup window.
- **Automatically close popup after (sec)** – this will added timer for automatically close popup window after amount of seconds
- **Display popup window after (sec)** – this will make window to appear after amount of seconds from page load (if nothing is provided window will pop up immediately after page load)

ADVANCED SETTINGS

Hide Social Network Names: This will display only social network icon.	<input type="radio"/> Yes <input checked="" type="radio"/> No

- **Hide Social Network Names** – this option will hide network names by default and they will appear only when you hover specific icon. Default will be visible only icons.

- **Don't pop network names** – this option works only when **Hide Social Network Names** is active and will not show network names when you hover icon – only icons will remain on screen. This option is activated and can't be turn off when you view site from mobile device.
- **Display counter of sharing** – this will display counters of sharing
- **Position of counters** – this option works when you have activated **Display counters of sharing** and allows you to choose position of counters
- **Position of total counter** – this will control position of total counter when display counters of sharing is active and you haven't checked Hide total counter option
- **Hide total counter when display counter of sharing is active** - this option works when you have activated **Display counters of sharing** and allows you to hide total counter
- **Display counters for native social buttons** – this allows you to select which counters for native social networks you wish to show
- **Load counters with admin-ajax.php call** – this option will make counters to load with ajax call to admin-ajax.php.



Shortcode Generator is tool that allows you easy to generate **shortcode** that can be included anywhere in content and render buttons. It has all available options that can be selected and used. When you fill settings for shortcode press generate shortcode button and you will see your code on top. Copy and paste where you wish to display buttons.

If you wish to use shortcode in old fashioned way here is list of parameters with their possible values:

- **buttons** with possible values:
facebook,twitter,mail,google,stumbleupon,linkedin,pinterest,digg,vk,tumblr,print
- **counters** with possible option 1 to display counters. If you don't wish to show them please don't put this parameter.
- **counters_pos** – this allows you to change counter position when counters=1. Default is left but you can pass value right to show counters on the right or inside to display counters instead of network names.
- **total_counter_pos** – this option allows you to change default render of total counter position when counters=1. You can use following values: left, leftbig, right, rightbig
- **hide_total** – this option allows you to hide total counter if you pass value yes
- **fullwidth** – if you wish buttons to be stretched to full width of content area pass this parameter with value yes
- **fullwidth_fix** – this parameter allows you to set button width (default passed values is 80). Value is in percent but you need to enter it with percent mark (%). If you use a lot of buttons you may need to decrease this value. If you use for example only facebook,twitter,google you need to increase and pass parameter value 85

- **url** – set up custom share url address
- **text** - set up custom share text
- **image** – set up custom share image (Facebook and Pinterest only)
- **description** – display custom description in share message (Facebook and Pinterest only)

- **native** – display or not native social network buttons if they are activated. By default option is set to use and if you wish to hide them use with value **no**. There is also option to select which of them to appear. In that case value should be set to **selected**.
- **show_fblike** – display Facebook Like Button when native="selected"

- **show_twitter** – display Twitter Follow Button when native="selected"
- **show_youtbue** – display YouTube subscribe button when native="selected"



To start collecting data you need to **activate Click log and statistics** option in **Main Settings**.







Click logging is done via javascript function call. If you have installed other plugin that handles tracking click (for example via Google Analytics using gag.push event) collecting may not work correct.
